**COUNT 1**


On or about August 2, 2017, in the Eastern District of Louisiana, in a matter within the jurisdiction of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development, an agency within the executive branch of the Government of the United States, **WESLEY TYRON BISHOP**, a resident of Orleans Parish, Louisiana, did knowingly and willfully make a false, fictitious, and fraudulent material statement and representation, in that the defendant represented
