COUNT 1

Beginning in or about March 2019, and continuing until in or about July 2020, in the Eastern District of Louisiana and elsewhere, the defendant, **NICOLE COCKERHAM**, did knowingly embezzle, steal, purloin, and convert to her use, money belonging to the United States and a department and agency thereof, namely, money of the Social Security Administration and the Internal Revenue Service, to which she knew she was not entitled, when she utilized approximately \$38,851.00 in Social Security Administration and Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act ("CARES ACT") funds.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 641.

has been commingled with other property which cannot be subdivided without e.

difficulty;

the United States shall seek a money judgment and, pursuant to Title 21, United States Code,

Section 853(p), forfeiture of any other property of the defendant up to the value of said property.
