COUNT ONE

The SPECIAL NOVEMBER 2023 GRAND JURY charges

On or about May 6, 2024, at Chicago, in the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division,

defendant herein, knowing that he had previously been convicted of a crime punishable by a term of imprisonment exceeding one year, did knowingly possess, in and affecting interstate commerce, ammunition, namely, sixteen .40 caliber rounds with a headstamp of "FEDERAL 40 S & W," three .40 caliber rounds with a headstamp of "HORNADY 40 S & W," two .40 caliber rounds with a headstamp of "CBC 40 S & W," five.40 caliber rounds with a headstamp of "AMMO INC 40 S & W," one .40 caliber round with a headstamp of "JAG 40 S & W," two rounds with a headstamp of "S & B 40 S & W," and two rounds with a headstamp of "TNQ 40 S & W," which ammunition had traveled in interstate commerce prior to defendant's possession of the ammunition;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

COUNT TWO

The SPECIAL NOVEMBER 2023 GRAND JURY charges:

Beginning no later than on or about May 6, 2024, and continuing until on or about May 24, 2024, at Chicago, in the Northern District of Illinois, Eastern Division, MARQUIST EVANS,

defendant herein, knowingly possessed a machinegun, as defined in Title 26, United States Code, Section 5845(b), namely, a loaded .40 caliber pistol, which shot automatically more than one shot, without manual reloading, by a single function of the trigger;

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(o)(1).
