I N F O R M A T I O N

The United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

(Violations of OSHA Standards Resulting in Death)

On or about August 8, 2019, in Passaic County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

ZONA ROOFING LLC,

willfully violated Occupational Safety and Health Administration (“OSHA”) standards, specifically 29 C.F.R. § 1926.503(a)(1), by willfully failing to provide, for each employee who might be exposed to fall hazards, a training program to enable each employee to recognize the hazards of falling and be trained in the procedures to be followed to minimize these hazards; and 29 C.F.R. § 1926.501(b)(13), by willfully failing to provide fall protection to employees engaged in residential construction activities 6 feet or more above lower levels; which caused the death of an employee.

In violation of Title 29, United States Code, Section 666(e).
