The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the Acting United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

On or about October 14, 2016, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

TRUSTWORTHY LLC,
d/b/a "Trustworthy Roofing and Siding"

an employer engaged in a business affecting interstate commerce, willfully violated standards, rules and orders promulgated by the Occupational Safety and Health Administration pursuant to Title 29, United States Code, Section, 655, namely, Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 1926.501(b)(13), by allowing an employee, Victim 1, to engage in residential construction activities six feet or more above lower levels without fall protection, resulting in Victim 1's death.

In violation of Title 29, United States Code, Section 666(e).
