INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about September 21, 2023, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **JENNIFER LYNN MILLER**, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally possessed with intent to distribute a controlled substance, and the offense involved 400 grams and more of a mixture and substance containing a detectable amount of fentanyl (N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl] propanamide).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A)(vi).

Count 2

On or about September 21, 2023, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **JENNIFER LYNN MILLER**, unlawfully, knowingly, and intentionally possessed

with intent to distribute a controlled substance, and the offense involved 50 grams and more of

methamphetamine.

In violation of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A)(viii).

Count 3

On or about October 23, 2023, in Bernalillo County, in the District of New Mexico, the

defendant, JENNIFER LYNN MILLER, knowingly escaped from the custody of Maya's Place,

an institutional facility in which she was lawfully confined by virtue of any process issued under

the laws of the United States by any court, judge, and magistrate judge, while charged with the

felony offenses of possession with intent to distribute 400 grams and more of fentanyl, in violation

of 21 U.S.C. §§ 841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(A)(vi) and possession with intent to distribute 50 grams and

more of a mixture and substance containing methamphetamine, in violation of 21 U.S.C. §§

841(a)(1) and (b)(1)(B)(viii).

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 751(a).
