INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about July 28, 2023, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendants, **RENAULDO SANDOVAL** and **LISA SANDOVAL**, Indians, assaulted Jane Doe 1, and the assault resulted in serious bodily injury.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153, 113(a)(6), and 18 U.S.C. § 2.

Count 2

On or about July 28, 2023, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **RENAULDO SANDOVAL**, having been convicted of:

- (1) Battery Against Household Member, N.M. Stat. 30-03-15, on or about March 28, 2003, which would be, if subject to Federal jurisdiction, an assault, the victim of which was Jane Doe 4, an intimate partner of **RENAULDO SANDOVAL**, and

(2) Battery Against Household Member, N.M. Stat. 30-3-15, on or about May 20, 2004, which would be, if subject to Federal jurisdiction, an assault, the victim of which was Jane Doe 4, an intimate partner of **RENAULDO SANDOVAL**, assaulted Jane Doe 2, a child of defendant **RENAULDO SANDOVAL**.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 117(a)(1).

Count 3

On or about July 28, 2023, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendants, **RENAULDO SANDOVAL** and **LISA SANDOVAL**, Indians, assaulted Jane Doe 3 with a dangerous weapon, specifically, defendant **LISA SANDOVAL**'s teeth, with the intent to do bodily harm.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 1153, 113(a)(3), and 18 U.S.C. § 2.
