INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

Count 1

On or about May 4, 2024, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **AVEDALE JOHNSON**, an Indian, and parent, guardian and custodian of Jane Doe 1, a minor under the age of 18, knowingly, recklessly, and without justifiable cause, operated a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, causing Jane Doe 1 to be placed in a situation that may have endangered the life and health of Jane Doe 1.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1153 and N.M. STAT. ANN. § 30-6-1(D).

Count 2

On or about May 4, 2024, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **AVEDALE JOHNSON**, an Indian, and parent, guardian and custodian of Jane Doe 2, a minor under the age of 18, knowingly, recklessly, and without justifiable cause, operated a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, causing Jane Doe 2 to be placed in a situation that may have endangered the life and health of Jane Doe 2.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1153 and N.M. STAT. ANN. § 30-6-1(D).

Count 3

On or about May 4, 2024, in Indian Country, in San Juan County, in the District of New Mexico, the defendant, **AVEDALE JOHNSON**, an Indian, and parent, guardian and custodian of Jane Doe 3, a minor under the age of 18, knowingly, recklessly, and without justifiable cause, operated a motor vehicle while under the influence of alcohol, causing Jane Doe 3 to be placed in a situation that may have endangered the life and health of Jane Doe 3.

In violation of 18 U.S.C. § 1153 and N.M. STAT. ANN. § 30-6-1(D).
