INDICTMENT

The Grand Jury charges:

From a date unknown, but no later than May 24, 2022, and continuing to on or about October 27, 2022, in Bernalillo, Rio Arriba, Santa Fe, and Valencia Counties, in the District of New Mexico, and elsewhere, the defendant, **DAVID ELIEZER SEAS-CENTENO**, unlawfully, knowingly and intentionally combined, conspired, confederated, agreed, and acted interdependently with other persons whose names are known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to commit an offense defined in 21 U.S.C. § 841(a)(1), specifically, distribution of a controlled substance.

Quantity of Fentanyl (N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl] propanamide)  
Involved in the Conspiracy

With respect to **DAVID ELIEZER SEAS-CENTENO**, the amount of fentanyl (N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl] propanamide) involved in the conspiracy attributable to him as a result of his own conduct, and the conduct of other conspirators reasonably foreseeable to him, is 400 grams and more of a mixture and substance containing a

detectable amount of fentanyl (N-phenyl-N-[1-(2-phenylethyl)-4-piperidinyl] propanamide),  
contrary to 21 U.S.C. § 841(b)(1)(A)(vi).

In violation of 21 U.S.C. § 846.
