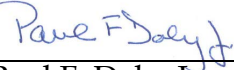
INFORMATION

The United States Attorney charges that:

On or about May 21, 2023, in the District of Rhode Island, the defendant, JONATHAN J. EINHORN, did willfully and knowingly make a materially false, fictitious, and fraudulent statement and representation in a matter within the jurisdiction of the executive branch of the Government of the United States, by falsely representing to a Correctional Officer of the Donald W. Wyatt Detention Facility, in Central Falls, Rhode Island, that he was not going to pass anything on to any detainees that he was visiting that day. The statement and representation were false because, as Jonathan J. Einhorn then and there knew, he intended to and did pass papers to a detainee that he was there to visit.

In violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 1001(a)(2).
