THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

COUNT ONE

On or about August 23, 2012, in the Northern District of Georgia, defendant JOSHUA LAMAR GREESON, a Deputy Sheriff with the Murray County Sheriff's Department, aided and abetted by others, knowingly attempted to corruptly persuade and engage in misleading conduct to Agents of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation, by making false statements to said Agents, with the intent to hinder, delay, and prevent the communication of information to a law enforcement officer of the United States relating to the commission and possible commission of a federal offense, in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 2 and 1512(b)(3).

COUNT TWO

On or about August 23, 2012, in the Northern District of Georgia, defendant JOSHUA LAMAR GREESON, a Deputy Sheriff with the Murray County Sheriff's Department, aided and abetted by others, knowingly altered, destroyed, concealed, and covered up a record and a tangible object with the intent to impede, obstruct, and influence an investigation of a matter within the jurisdiction of a department and agency of the United States, and in relation to

and contemplation of such investigation, in violation of Title 18,
United States Code, Sections 2 and 1519.


