
The defendant having waived in open court prosecution by Indictment, the United States Attorney for the District of New Jersey charges:

From in or about January 2012, through on or about December 7, 2012, in Camden County, in the District of New Jersey and elsewhere, the defendant,

ALEXANDER VARGAS,

knowingly embezzled, stole and converted to his own use, and the use of others, property of the United States, that is, benefits from the United States Department of Agriculture, Supplemental Nutrition and Assistance Program (formerly known as the Federal Food Stamp Program), having a value in excess of \$2,500,000, which came into his possession and control by virtue of his participation in the business of Eddies Grocery Store, 1548 Mount Ephraim Avenue, Camden, New Jersey, a then-authorized retailer for the United States Department of Agriculture, Supplemental Nutrition and Assistance Program.

All in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Sections 641 and 2.
