ORDER

RICHARD J. SULLIVAN, District Judge:

The Court is in receipt of a letter, dated March 2, 2010, from Defendant, requesting a two-month extension of time in which to file his submissions and a two-month adjournment of sentencing. The government does not object to this request. Accordingly, Defendant's request is granted. IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that

- (1) Submissions in regard to issues of loss and forfeiture shall be received by May 5, 2010;
- (2) Oral argument on issues related to loss and forfeiture is scheduled for Friday, May 28, 2010 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 21C, United States District Court, 500 Pearl Street, New York, New York;
- (3) Pre-sentencing submissions shall be received by June 16, 2010; and
- (4) Sentencing is scheduled for Wednesday, June 30, 2010 at 2:30 p.m. in Courtroom 21C, United States District Court, 500 Pearl Street, New York, New York.

All submissions shall be sent electronically to sullivannysdchambers@nysd.uscourts.gov and courtesy copies shall be mailed or hand delivered to chambers.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the government shall post this Order on its website and that the Victim/Witness Coordinator shall notify victims, who have already made submissions, of these scheduling changes. All other victims who wish to be heard on issues related to loss and forfeiture shall make submissions to the Victim/Witness Coordinator by April 30, 2010. All other victims who wish to be heard in connection with general sentencing issues shall make

submissions to the Victim/Witness Coordinator by June 10, 2010. The Victim/Witness Coordinator shall forward all submissions, with proper redactions, to the Court via the Court's Electronic Case Filing system.
