INDICTMENT

COUNT ONE

THE GRAND JURY CHARGES THAT:

On or about December 6, 2012, in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania, defendant

JOHNNY REYES-AGRAMONTE, a/k/a "Johnny Reyes-Castillo," a/k/a "Santo Johnny Reyes-Castillo," a/k/a "Juan Sierra,"

an alien, and native and citizen of the Dominican Republic, who had previously been deported and removed from the United States on or about April 10, 1997, June 16, 1999, and May 11, 2004, was found in the United States, having knowingly and unlawfully reentered the United States without first applying to the Attorney General of the United States or his successor, the Secretary for Homeland Security (Title 6, United States Code, Sections 202(3), (4) and 557), for permission to reapply for admission, and without receiving in response the express consent of the Attorney General or his successor to reapply for admission. In violation of Title 8, United States Code, Section 1326(a) and (b)(2).
